

On behalf of the Association's Scholarship Committee, we are pleased to announce that the USS Saratoga Association Scholarship Program application forms are now available on our website at

www.uss-saratoga.com

As you will read on the application, the scholarship is open to all students in their senior year of High School who are one of the following:

A son or a daughter, or a grandson or granddaughter, or a great-grandson or a great-granddaughter of a USS Saratoga Association Member (Sponsor) who has served aboard the Saratoga, and has been an Association member in good standing for a minimum of the past 12 months. In good standing infers the member is current with their dues payments.

Two scholarships will be awarded. Each one is valued at \$1,000.00 and each one will be awarded on a one-time, non-renewable basis as follows;

(1) One scholarship will be awarded to a student attending a 4-year or a 2-year College Program.

(2) One scholarship will be awarded to a student attending a Technical, Trade, Medical or a Dental school, or an Administrative Support school.
